HealthProm Annual Summer Concert

6.30pm, 4th June 2009
Sutton's Hospital in Charterhouse

The Patron of HealthProm, **Baroness Smith of Gilmorehill**, invites you to a summer party on June 4th in aid of HealthProm's work in Russia, Central Asia and the Transcaucasus.

The evening will feature classical, modern and traditional music by Russian and British performers, with champagne, canapés and speeches.

The venue at Charterhouse Square, London EC1M 6AN (between Barbican and Farringdon tube stations) was founded as a Carthusian monastery in 1371 and is formally known as *Sutton's Hospital in Charterhouse*. Since the dissolution of the monasteries in 1537, the house has served as a private mansion, a boys' school (Charterhouse) and an almshouse. Queen Elizabeth I occupied the building before her coronation, and James I held court here on his first entrance into London in 1603.

The evening will commence at 6.30pm with a champagne reception.

The concert will start at 7.30pm with soloists Sarah Harrison, Igor Outkine, Anna Gorbacheva, Julian Gallant.

- ***Beethoven's Moonlight Sonata***, performed by Julian Gallant (piano)
- ***Iolanthe's aria from Iolanthe (Tchaikovsky), O, do not sing for me (Rachmaninoff), Margarita's aria from Faust (Gounod)***, performed by Anna Gorbacheva (soprano)
- ***Vivaldi, Rachmaninoff, Piazzolla, gypsy music and Russian traditional music***, performed by Sarah Harrison (violin) and Igor Outkine (accordion).

At 8.30pm there will be a finger buffet with drinks and speeches, followed by a fund-raising auction and raffle. HealthProm trustees will be in attendance.

Igor Outkine studied classical accordion at Scriabin Music College (Elektrostal) and traditional singing at the Gnessin Institute (Moscow). He came to London in 1990 and has continued to perform the music of his homeland in various venues, performing on stage, TV and film and CD.

Sarah Harrison trained as a classical violinist at the Guildhall School of Music & Drama in London, after which extensive travels enabled her to experiment with many other musical styles. She has worked with different orchestras and bands, appearing widely in the theatre, such as the Theatre Royal, Haymarket, at the National Theatre and the Purcell Room.

Julian Gallant is a concert pianist and a conductor. He studied at the University of Oxford and in Switzerland. He has performed widely, including the Orchestre de Chambre de Lausanne and the Moscow Virtuosi, and has conducted all over Russia, including productions with Helikon Opera Moscow. He has worked with The Royal Philharmonic Orchestra and the Salzburg Mozarteum Orchestra. He is a well-known accompanist and impresario, importing classical music, ballet and opera. He is Director of Pushkin House in London.

Anna Gorbacheva was born in the Urals. She is studying for a Masters at the Royal College of Music and has won prizes at the RCM, the Siena International Opera Singing Competition and the Antonin Dvorak Vocal Competition.
